Apply now for the Caldwell Alumni Coaching Certification Program

Professional coaching has become a major tool for supporting the development of our Fellows. Coaching is a powerful avenue for leadership and we are pleased to have a program that supports current Fellows while also investing in the development of our alumni. For the third year, the program will subsidize professional coaching certification for three to four Caldwell Fellows alumni who in turn will commit to providing volunteer coaching to one or more Fellows each year for a minimum of three years. Our seven alumni who have completed the training speak of the program's excellent design and highly recommend our continuation of this offering. The training is formidable in time commitment and rigor and results in becoming a certified professional coach. The invitation is now open for alumni to apply for consideration for the 2023-24 coach training program.
