



The Call for Selection Volunteers

Caldwell Fellows Selection Season will soon be upon us. The application closes on January 13, 2026. We expect a record number of applicants again this year. As ever, it's an exciting process and one that we cannot do without dedicated volunteers like you. We need volunteers for each stage of the process. You can lear more about the timelines and commitment of each role below.

- Online reviews (January 16 22) this consists of reviewing and ranking a set of applications on your own following our criteria rubric.
- Semi-finalist day (Saturday, February 7, on Main Campus) this is a full day of small group interactions with applicants. This continues to be a fruitful vetting stage in our selection process.
- Selection day/finalist interviews (Saturday, February 21, on Centennial Campus) this is the main event in which each of the 60 finalists are interviewed multiple times and evaluated.

The brief interest form linked below details the stages and timelines. Express your interest by December 16; we will contact you that week to confirm your role.

2026 Caldwell Alumni Conference: *Rooted "l"eadership: Grounded in values*

In alignment with this year's Caldwell Fellows focus on rootedness, the 2026 Alumni Conference will explore the kaleidoscope of shared values that are foundational to the program while also considering the sources of our individual values and how they are expressed in our daily lives. We will reflect on how we act on values and how they are expressed through leadership in the big "L" aspects and small "L" moments.

This conference is designed to allow for introspection and collaboration – What is community? How does one respond to the obligation to show up? What does 'leadership for public purpose' look like? What does leading in the quiet ways mean to you and your community? How do you prioritize actionable leadership? How do we help people go into spaces where there are value crunches? Throughout the day we will discuss and explore the moments of curiosity where there is friction and the moments where humanity and commonality can be found in shared values though the approaches may be different.

Our goal is for you to walk away with (re)new(ed) skills to engage in your communities and have bridging conversations through small "L" leadership moments. During the conference, you will also learn about Caldwell Fellows alumni affinity groups that provide a community of practice and further opportunities to dive deeper into these discussed topics.

Conference cost is \$100 and includes learning resources, conference space at the StateView Hotel, breakfast and lunch.
